How to Give a Good Talk

Making public presentations becomes currently more and more important in various areas of activities, including research. Nevertheless, the presentation skills are not taught in the standard programs for chemistry and physics students in many European universities. I teach during several years a Master degree course “Transferrable Scientific and Linguistic Skills” in the Faculty of Chemistry, Universitat de Barcelona. Among the main aims of the course is improving the students’ presentation abilities and making research presentations at conferences and seminars more professional and successful.

In this lecture I provide general advices for preparing research presentations and giving better talks as well as I share my experience of teaching the course in Barcelona. Those, who would like to get a critical feedback on their presentations, will be able to make an appointment for that.
